

Transition to Primary School

The EYFS curriculum also continues into Primary School. Your child's first year at Primary School is known as the Foundation Stage year where children will be nearing the end of the EYFS curriculum, focusing on the statements within the 30-50 and 40-60 month curriculum age bands.

We will create and send on a transition document and aim to have regular meetings/correspondence with your child's chosen Primary School practitioners, in order to best provide your child with a smooth transition into their Primary School Education.

Our main feeder schools that we have strong links with are local schools Charmouth Primary and Marshwood C of E Aided Primary, however we can make and develop links with whatever your chosen school is.

Staff from Primary Schools are invited in to Pre-School to visit the children they will be welcoming to school in the following September. We also hold coffee mornings where parents can chat to Primary School teaching staff.

With our feeder children that go to Marshwood School, we have managed to take the children to the school for pre-visits with our staff before they start attending Pre-School sessions at the school. This has really helped with the transition process, as it has been very useful for the children, parents and the school teaching staff.
